### 54. To Consider any issues relating to Huntington Riverside Environmental Park

The Committee are awaiting quotes for the footpath proposal and it is likely that they will approach the Parish Council for funding, whilst this idea is supported in principle, the Amenities Committee Recommended that; The Full Parish ask the Environmental Park Committee send a copy of their Terms of Reference.to the Parish Council and hold an AGM as it would appear that an AGM hasn't been held during the recent Covid period, however it is now deemed safe to hold such meetings and the committee should meet as soon as practically possible

#### To Consider any other issues relating to Huntington Parish Councils' Open Spaces 55.

LF had asked Sleightholm's to prepare ground for wildflowers, however this had not been possible due to the extremely dry weather making the ground very hard and impossible to scarify it was **Recommended** that; this work be undertaken in November for flowering in Summer 2023.

GC (RFO) and LF met with a representative from CoYC (Beki Hagger) to discuss possible areas for tree planting within the parish short notice was given by the CoYC representative (6pm the night before) and it was impossible to contact anyone from the various subcommittees, so HSSC, Foss riverbank and the Barratt site on New Lane were visited. KO has had no response from Yorkshire Housing about the drainage issue with the footpath to the rear of Garth Road play area, Cllr Smith is sending LF the contact details for a drainage company.

Orchard Park access route to the BMX track and the footpath at the right-hand side have both begun to split and cracks are appearing it is **Recommended** that; quotes be obtained for tarmacking both footpaths.

The wall to the rear of the community centre at Orchard Park is being damaged by the penetration of the Virginia Creeper from the neighbouring garden, it was *Agreed* that: LF would write a strongly worded letter, if this is unsuccessful then it is Recommended that: the Parish Council solicitor be instructed
